
HEALTHY HYGIENE & CLEANING



- In an effort to maintain high health standards and minimize the spread of viruses, hand washing and sanitizing will be required. Students and staff members will wash or sanitize their hands at the following times:
 - Upon arrival
 - After diapering/ bathroom breaks
 - Before/after eating
 - Before/after recess
 - After coughing/sneezing



- Enhanced cleaning routines have been established in all classrooms and play areas. The Ark area will be cleaned and disinfected each day. Highly touched surfaces, such as tables, chairs, doorknobs, toys, shared items, etc. will be sanitized throughout the day as well.




FACE COVERINGS

CDO teachers & staff members will wear facial coverings when closely interacting with students.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Classes will not be combining for outside/gym times
- Classes will be spaced out for Chapel worship



VISITORS

- At this time, all Children's areas are closed to visitors to minimize the risk of exposure.
- Anyone entering the Children's area will be required to wear face coverings during their visit.
- If you must pick your child up early, please use the intercom system on the front door. You will be let into the building, but please ring the bell outside the Ark doors & wait outside the Ark area. We will bring your child to you. Please notify the Director in advance.



SYMPTOM SCREENING

Parents are required to screen their child for the following symptoms at home each day. By coming to school, you are certifying that your child has been free from all of the following symptoms for the last 24 hours or until released by a doctor.



SYMPTOM SCREEN

- Fever (temperature equal to 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher)
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Headache
- Chills
- Shortness of breath or difficulty of breathing
- Muscle or body aches
- Fatigue
- Loss of taste or smell
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Recent interactions with COVID-19 diagnosed persons

CONFIRMED OR ASSUMED CASES

SCREENING FOR COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

Children First is working hard to keep everyone healthy, and there are also plans in place if there is an illness while on campus.

- Teachers and staff members will monitor students and refer them to the Director if symptoms are suspected to be present.
- An isolated space has been configured for anyone who becomes ill while at school with symptoms associated with COVID-19.
- Parents will be contacted and the child **MUST** be picked up within 30 minutes by a parent or by someone on the approved pickup list.
- In the event of a confirmed COVID-19 case or exposure to a confirmed COVID-19 case, families must follow public health guidelines and instructions, including notification of Children First, Children's Day Out & Preschool.



RETURNING TO SCHOOL



If a student/employee tests positive for COVID-19, the person should not return to school until:

1. 10 days have passed since symptoms started; AND
2. 24 hours have passed with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medicine; AND
3. Other symptoms are improving

If a student/employee has close contact who is COVID-19 positive:

If the student/employee is fully vaccinated, the person should not return until:

1. No quarantine is required as long as the person remains asymptomatic;
2. Even if asymptomatic, the person should get tested 3-5 days after their exposure; AND
3. The person should wear a mask indoors at school for 14 days after their exposure or until their negative test results.

If the student/employee is NOT fully vaccinated, the person should not return until:

1. 10 days have passed since last exposure
2. 7 days have passed since last exposure and the person has received a negative test result from DAY 5 or later from a verified testing location
